A wide choice of cosmetic treatments are available to achieve your goals, including ceramic tooth restorations, tooth whitening, implants, orthodontics, tooth resculpting and tooth coloured composite restorations. Some of these are outlined below.

Tooth whitening is one of our most popular treatments. We offer in-house and take home kits, giving you two simple choices. We use the most effective materials, together with expert care and advice to reach the desired result. Booster kits are also available for top ups over the years if necessary.

Implants are a realistic, strong and permanent support for replacing a single missing tooth or a number of teeth, a great modern alternative to dentures and bridges. Implants comprise of a metal screw, which replaces the natural tooth root and supports the aesthetic tooth so it blends perfectly with your natural teeth.

Veneers are porcelain facings for teeth that are bonded to your natural tooth with minimal invasion. They can transform your smile, erasing many imperfections such as crooked, stained, spaced or uneven teeth.

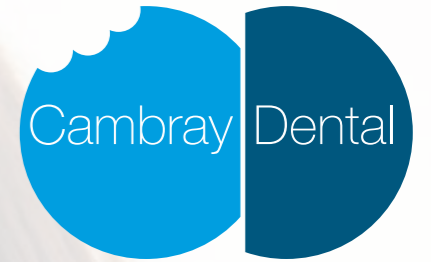
Disabled access

Keeping your teeth for life



With our policy of preventative dentistry, we request patients to return at regular intervals to enable you to achieve and maintain a good level of oral health and minimise treatment needs.

The foundation of a great smile is, of course, strong and healthy teeth and gums. Therefore we feel it is of great importance to spend time advising you on the best ways to care for them at home.

Our hygienists play a key role in the care and treatment we provide, specialising in periodontal care. Gingivitis (gum disease) is very common and early symptoms may include bleeding, swollen, sore gums and bad breath. If left untreated it may progress to periodontitis that could result in eventual tooth loss.

During your hygiene appointment, plaque, a sticky layer of bacteria and the calcified form, calculus (tartar) will be removed; this will help prevent the onset of gingivitis and periodontal disease.
